

Manor Yorkshire stone is a fine grain sandstone. The durability of the stone is well known since it has been tested in varying uses and has proven durable in excess of 150 years. The colour of the newly quarried stone is grey to buff. The appearance of the stone is enhanced through natural weathering, this causes the colour to change to a rich buff.

Bingley stone cuts this stone with diamond cutting machinery to produce paving slabs of the finest quality. Our manor paving flags are sawn to a fine tolerance and the surfaces are machined to a provide slabs of equal thickness and a smooth, flat finish.

Manor stone is the choice for Bingley stone's masonry services due to the excellent properties the stone offers, it is used in all areas of masonry work such as steps and risers, copings, heads and cills, walling, and arches etc.

Colour Pale buff to grey enriched through ageing.

Standard Thickness's 38mm, 50mm, 63mm, 75mm, 100mm, 150mm

Weights Approximately .425 cubic metres per tonne.


Pencil Round
