Technical Specifications

Duturo can be applied to any backing that is firm and true and will not crack. However, the two preferred substrates are taped and jointed plasterboard and freshly plastered walls that are fully dry.

SUITABLE SUBSTRATES

- Taped and jointed plasterboard
- Gypsum plaster
- Glass reinforced gypsum (GRG)
- Cement render
- Blueclad cement particle board
- Previously painted surfaces (paint must be well adhered)
- Metal surfaces treated with a suitable metal primer
- MDF as a single panel

UNSUITABLE SUBSTRATES

- Wallpaper
- Lining paper
- Vinyl wall covering
- Particle board
- Glazed ceramic tiles
- Polyester lacquered surfaces

Allow 7 days curing time for maximum performance. We recommend that Duturo is applied by trained applicators.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

Duturo can be easily washed and scrubbed without affecting the surface. For areas where the likelihood of scuffing and marking is high, a clear seal coat can be applied to the surface for added protection (additional cost applies).


