Notes for preparation:

- ► The substrate must be permanently dry, hard, load-bearing, plane, free from grease, dust and silicon, in accordance with the respective national standards (EN, DIN, VOB, OE, SIA).
- ▶ Wallpaper must be firmly bonded or cut/removed for the height covered by the skirting.
- ▶ Bind dust with a solvent-free primer (e.g. UZIN PE 260).
- ► The floor covering and Linomur must be adequately free from tension before installation and acclimatized to the indoor climate.

The following is needed:

Linomur, pressure roller (rubbing tool), rubbing hammer, carpet knife



Installing curved linoleum skirting:



- Mark skirting height (10 cm) on the wall
- Affix Linomur flush to the marking on the wall



 In addition, apply a strip of Linomur at a distance of approx. 2 cm from the wall on the floor



► Loosely put down the curved skirting and cut the protective paper along the edge



- Remove the protective paper from the floor section
- Place curved element against the wall and put down on the floor with exact fit



- Thoroughly roll/rub over the floor section
- Fold the loose wall section forward
- Remove the protective paper from the wall section



- ► Fold up the wall section and thoroughly roll/rub over
- Roll out the sheets and fold back half way



- Spread the adhesive both on the substrate and (partially) on the protective paper with a notched trowel
- Remove the protective paper immediately



Slide the floor covering in place and rub/roll over

Important notes:

Store in a dry, cool area and without exposure to direct sunlight. Skirting strips can only be installed once adequately relieved from tension (only as an upstanding).

Skirting strips must be cut to size in longitudinal direction. Installation instructions for linoleum skirting strips is described in the Linomur® 45 data sheet.

Protection of the workplace and the environment:

The product does not require any special labour protection measures. For reasons of working hygiene, we recommend avoiding eating, drinking and smoking during processing of this product. Store out of the reach of children.

Sleeves and carton packaging free from residues can be recycled. Material residues can be disposed of with domestic waste.

Warranty:

UZIN grants a 5-year warranty for all properties claimed in the processing instructions.

- the floor covering was installed under pulling forces or tension.
- · Linomur is exposed to moisture.
- installation was performed below 18 °C (on the wall).
- Linomur is used in areas with increased humidity or thermal exposures (e.g. conservatories).
