The system is also designed to integrate into existing automatic door opening systems. The system can be integrated into existing systems and contains enough redundancy to include additional functions bespoke and specific to customer requirements.

STAFF CONTROLLED PUBLIC ACCESS SYSTEM

Staff Controlled Public Access System enables staff to remotely control how many people can enter a premises. A typical application would be in a bank whereby the staff can utilise the system from inside the secure area. A typical installation would include a Maglock installed on the entry door and a red/green traffic lights installed to indicate to the public if they may enter or not.

MAIN FEATURES

- Allows staff to have full control of people entering the branch
- Can be used with existing access control
- A resettable call point will be installed inside the branch which will override the maglock in the event of an emergency
- An umbrella switch will be installed on the outer door frame in case staff open the door, turn back on the locking system, and leave the branch
- The controller buttons are located at the counter position and have a light to indicate the status of the lock, red for locked and green to indicate open

OPTIONAL

- Installation of doorbell so the public are not reliant on staff constantly watching out for customers
- An additional option would be a key switch override to turn the whole system off



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
