#### **PURPOSE**

Rapid drying filler, for interior use, in powder, manual application.

# **SUBSTRATES**

PATCH & REPAIR FILLER QUICK DRY can be applied to new or renovated, painted or unpainted substrates:

• Gypsum plaster, plaster boards

- Old painted surfaces
- · Cement, concrete, cellular concrete, breeze blocks, bricks, stone
- Primed wood

#### **OVERCOATING**

PATCH & REPAIR FILLER QUICK DRY can be overcoated with any filler, any conventional paint or conventional wall-coating. Do not cover directly with polyurethane or solvent-based epoxy

If using a solvent based paint, a first primer coat of water-based masonry paint is highly recommended.

# Physical and technical **FEATURES**

PATCH & REPAIR FILLER QUICK DRY: filler in powder, made of selected quary material and resin.

- Characterization (NFT 36-005): Familly III Class 3
- Codification (EN 16-566): G<sub>3</sub>S<sub>2</sub>V<sub>0</sub>W<sub>0</sub>A<sub>0</sub>C<sub>0</sub>R<sub>0</sub>
- Mixing rate: 45% water (hence .45 I water for 1 kg powder)
- Application thickness: not limited
- Consumption: 1 kg powder fills 1 l of volume
  Working time: 30 to 40 minutes
- Second coat: when the filler is touch dry and sandable
- Painted/overcoated: in 3 hrs average time (time relevant to a thickness coat of 1 cm)
- Colour: extra white
- Shore hardness: 80
- Adherence filler-substrate: (EN 16-566): >0.5 MP

# **USE AND STORAGE CONDITIONS**

- Application tools: coating knife, blade or trowel.
- Tools cleaning: with water.
- Preservation: product guaranteed 12 months, from the original purchase invoice date as evidence, in its original sealed packaging and stored away from humidity.

# **PACKAGING**

• Box of 1 kg and 2 kg, Bag of 5 kg.

# RECOMMENDATIONS and care for use

- Do not apply PATCH & REPAIR FILLER QUICK DRY on polystyrene or on wall paper or any bonded coverings. Do not apply on exterior substrates.
- Do not apply: under a temperature below 8°C nor above 35°C nor at an hygrometry rate above 70%.
- Do not apply on overheated surfaces.
- · Do not apply on damp surfaces or when condensation conditions are likely to occur.
- . Do not further mix the paste once it has begun to set.

# **SUBSTRATES PREPARATION**

- Substrates to be prepared as per the current trade practices.
- Substrates must be hard, cohesive, clean, sound and dry.
