Description

Sovereign Admix Concentrate has for over thirty years been the choice of the professional. Generations of builders have used and trusted Sovereign Admix. Being based on Vinsol Resin and not synthetic resins it gives mortars excellent working properties.

Properties

Sovereign Admix is an air-entraining admixture that improves the workability of mortars. Microscopic air bubbles cause the mortar to become 'lubricated' so making the mix plastic and workable.

The added advantage of air-entraining admixtures is that they reduce the amount of water required so improving the cure of a mortar. They also improve protection of the mortar from frost damage during laying and for the life of the mortar.

Sovereign Admix Concentrate has been independently tested to and passes EN 934-3: Admixtures for Masonry Mortar

PREPARATION

Can be either added straight into the mix or a gauging solution can be made by diluting 1 litre of Admix Concentrate with 40 litres of water.

USAGE

Sovereign Admix Concentrate can be added direct to the mix. The exact quantity of Admix required would depend on mix size; mix ratio and the sand being used. As a guide 125–250 ml will be sufficient for a mix containing 50 kg of cement.

COVERAGE

A 25 litre tin will be sufficient for up to 200 mixes. Caution should be taken not to overdose the mix, as this will have a detrimental effect. Similarly do not over-mix as this will introduce excessive air resulting in a weak mix.

Storage: Between 5°C – 25°C.

Shelf Life: 12 months unopened.
